Request for a Statement from the Chairperson of the Committee on National Security and Foreign Relations on the murder of Mr. Musa Koech

Mr. Speaker, pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (b), I rise to seek a statement from the Chairperson of the Committee on National Security and Foreign Relations on the murder of Mr. Musa Koech, a resident of Chepkuny village in Bonjoge, Aldai, Nandi County.

Mr. Speaker, on 22nd September, 2016, Mr. Ekirapa, a police officer from Cheptulu police post, allegedly shot and killed the said Mr. Musa Koech while on his way home at about 9:30 pm. The postmortem results confirmed that the shooting was the cause of his death.

Mr. Speaker, in his statement, the Chairperson should address the following:-

- a) The state of security at the border of Nandi and Vihiga Counties and specifically provide a copy of the occurrence book in Cheptulu Police Post and Serem Police Station for the period between 22nd and 24th September, 2016;
- b) The status of the investigations into this particular incident and whether the alleged police officer has been arrested and charged of the said murder;
- c) Can the Government undertake to compensate the family of Mr. Musa Koech; and
- d) The steps the Government is taking to curb the rising cases of extrajudicial killings by the police in the region.
