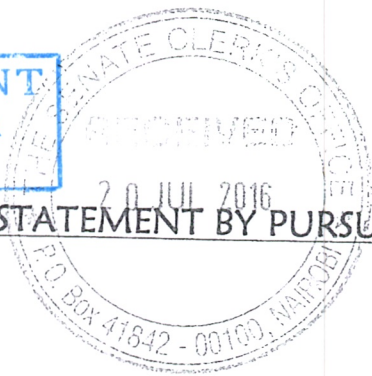

REQUEST FOR STATEMENT BY PURSUANT TO STANDING ORDER 45 (2) (B)

Mr. Speaker Sir,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (b) I rise to seek a Statement from the Chairperson of the Standing Committee on Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries regarding the fate of tea farmers who lost tea sales money in the collapse of Imperial Bank and Chase Bank.

In the Statement, the Chairperson should address the following matters-

1. Is the Chairperson aware that tea farmers affiliated to the Kenya Tea Development Agency Limited (KTDA) cannot access Ksh. 4.8 Billion deposited in Imperial Bank and Chase Bank?
2. Could the Central Bank of Kenya (CBK) intervene to ensure that KTDA is allowed to access the entire deposits in both banks, on behalf of affiliate factories, to facilitate payment of this year's bonus to tea farmers?
3. Could the national Government prevail upon KTDA to pay farmers in excess of 75% of what is due to the farmers monthly for the deliveries made in order to reduce the amount of money withheld yearly by KTDA and deposited in various banks, ostensibly to earn interest?
4. Could the national Government, through a directive, compel KTDA to operate within its core mandate of processing and marketing tea and minimize the establishment of subsidiary companies that often lead to the temptation of retaining huge sums of money held in banks?

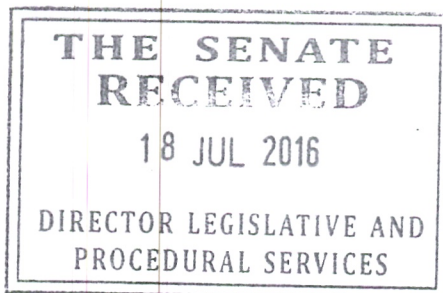
