COMPENSATION AND RECOGNITION AS A HERO OF KENNETH MATIBA

THIRD SCHEDULE

GENERAL FORM OF A PUBLIC PETITION

(STANDING ORDER 223)

We, the undersigned residents of Kiharu constituency within Murang'a County do hereby draw the attention of the house to the following,

1. That Stanley Kenneth Njindo Matiba is a Kenyan politician born in 1942 in Murang'a county, became a senior civil servant before Kenya attained its independence in 1963, where he continued with his service till December 1988 where he resigned and joined active politics.
2. That Matiba was a pioneer of the second liberation of Kenya.
3. That Matiba was arrested and detained without trial on the 4th July 1990 by Moi regime at the height of political clamor for political pluralism.
4. While in prison Matiba was denied medication and suffered a stroke that affected half his body and was flown to London for specialized treatment soon after his release and he suffers the aftermath of this stroke to date.
5. Upon his release and introduction of multi party elections in December 1992; Matiba with his Ford Asili Party came in second in the presidential elections. He however won the seat for Kiharu constituency in concurrent parliamentary elections.
6. That following his detention his Hillcrest School was sold by administrators under contestable circumstances.
7. That his hotel chain Alliance Group of Hotels property was seized by a bank upon his incarceration that mismanaged the property and tried unsuccessfully to auction it only after lobbying by the Matiba family. The circumstances caused the collapse of the Chain finally.
8. That currently, Matiba despite his continued fight for democracy is yet to be recognized as a hero.



7. Shall create a policy that will ensure all individuals contributing immeasurably to Kenya's progress are not forgotten.











