INTRODUCTION

The Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2013 Section 29 stipulates that the Board shall, on a monthly basis; submit a report to the National Assembly Select Committee detailing the following;

- a) A summary of the project proposals received from the constituencies in the preceding month and indicating the approval status of such projects;
- (b) A summary of the status of disbursements of funds to the constituencies for that preceding month;
- (c) A summary of the status of disbursements from the Treasury to the National Account;
- (d) Any restriction imposed on a constituency account in accordance with the Act.

Section 30 of the CDF Act 2013 further stipulates that the Board shall ensure that the list of projects forwarded to it by each constituency is, upon approval, funded in accordance with the Act.

The report submitted for the month of November, 2013 covered details of disbursement of funds as at 5th December, 2013. This report covers details of projects proposals for 2013/14 Financial Year and updates on the status of disbursement of funds as at 10th January, 2014.

A. SUMMARY OF PROJECTS PROPOSALS FOR 2013/14 FINANCIAL YEAR

The CDF Board held its meeting on 18th December, 2013 to deliberate on projects proposals for 2013/14 Financial Year among other issues. The Board deliberated on one hundred and sixty four (164) projects proposals out of which one hundred and thirty five (135) complied with the provisions of the CDF Act, 2013 hence had all their projects approved. See details in Annex I

Twenty Nine (29) Constituencies however had some of their proposed projects either declined, deferred and others approved conditionally due to either non compliance with the provisions of the CDF Act, 2013, need for more information to be submitted by the CDFCs while others needed policy direction.
