The Public Petition on harassment and confiscation of Slot and Gaming Machines belonging to the members of Counties Amusement and Gaming Society was presented to the National Assembly by the Hon. George Theuri, MP on 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 pursuant to Standing Order 225(2) and the Petition to Parliament (Procedure) Act, 2012. The petition dated 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 prays “that the National Assembly through the Departmental Committee on Sports, Culture and Tourism:

- (i) Cause an investigation into the alleged harassment of the Members of the Counties Amusement and Gaming Society and confiscation of their property by authorities;
- (ii) Recommends that Kenyans be allowed to own, manage and franchise slot and gaming machines as stipulated by the Betting, lotteries and Gaming Act; and
- (iii) Makes any other order or direction that it deems fit in the circumstances of the matter.

The Committee wishes to thank the Offices of the Speaker and the Clerk of the National Assembly for the support extended to it in the execution of its mandate.

I take this opportunity to thank all the Members of the Committee for their patience, sacrifice, endurance and hard work during the long sitting hours under tight schedules, which enabled us to complete the tasks within the stipulated period.

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report contains the Committee's proceedings during the hearing of the Public Petition on harassment and confiscation of Slot and Gaming Machines belonging to the members of Counties Amusement and Gaming Society was presented to the National Assembly by the Hon. George Theuri, MP on 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2018. While considering the petition, the Committee noted the following:

1. THAT the Counties Amusement and Gaming Society (herein referred to as the Society) is registered society of persons who are engaged in the gaming and amusement industry. The society indicated that they have 600 registered members, however, no proof was provided or list of the registered members to support this;
2. THAT, the Committee established that the some Members of the Society had been charged in court for various offences which were withdrawn by the Office of the Directorate of Public Prosecution under section 87(a) of the Criminal procedure Code.
3. THAT, the Members of the Society have filed various Petitions in several courts challenging the harassment of the Police; A case in point is the Constitutional Petition Number 482 of 2018 which has all the registered members of the Society as Petitioners in the matter.
4. THAT, HC. Pet. No. 482 of 2018 was filed in July 2018 against the Betting Control and Licensing Board, the Ministry of Interior and National Co-ordination, Inspector General, Attorney General, Office of the Directorate of Public Prosecution, Council of Governors and Inter-Governmental Technical Relations Committee.
5. THAT the HC. Pet. No. 482 of 2018 was mentioned on the 25<sup>th</sup> July 2018 whereas the Petition before the Committee was tabled in the House on the 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 during the subsistence of the suit in Court.

Having considered the petition, the Committee was dissatisfied with the petitioner's submission because the Petition did not disclose whether there were pending matters in court contrary to the Petitions to Parliament ( Procedure) Act, the parties therefore did not disclose all the information as required therefore fail the test of equity of full disclosure.

## **1.0 MANDATE OF THE COMMITTEE**

  - (f) vet and report on all appointments where the Constitution or any law requires the National Assembly to approve, except those under Standing Order 204 (*Committee on Appointments*); and
- Make reports and recommendations to the House as often as possible, including recommendation of proposed legislation.

### 1.3 FINDINGS OF THE COMMITTEE

In its findings, the Committee noted that:

1. The issues raised and the prayers in the Petition are similar in an active Petition before the High Court HC. Pet. No. 482 of 2018; under Standing order 89, the Committee shall not refer to any matter which is *subjudice* in this case an active matter in court.
2. The Petitioners failed the test of disclosure; They ought to disclose information as required by the Petitions to Parliament (Procedure) Act which they failed;

### RECOMMENDATION

After considering the Petition and having made the above findings,

**The Committee recommends that the Petition be dismissed pursuant to Standing Order 89.**

## 2.0 INTRODUCTION

### 2.1 Background Information

Article 119(1) of the Constitution provides that every person has a right to petition Parliament to consider any matter within its authority, including enacting, amending or repealing any legislation. This Particular provision is operationalized by the Petitions to Parliament (Procedure) Act, 2012 and Standing Orders 219 and 220.

The Public Petition on harassment and confiscation of Slot and Gaming Machines belonging to the members of Counties Amusement and Gaming Society was presented to the National Assembly by the Hon. George Theuri, MP on 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 pursuant to Standing Order 225(2)(a) and the Petition to Parliament (Procedure) Act, 2012. In accordance with Standing Order 227, the petition was referred to the Departmental Committee on Sports, Culture and Tourism for consideration and preparation of a report.

### 2.2 The Petition

The petitioners wished to draw the attention of the House to the following:-

- i) **THAT**, the Counties Amusement and Gaming Society is a Kenyan owned organization duly registered by the Society Act and with over 600 registered members.
- ii) **THAT**, the Counties Amusement and Gaming Society of Kenya operates legal business with the necessary permits from County Governments and they have complied with all statutory regulations as well as upholding to the high standards set by the Betting, Lotteries and Gaming Act;
- iii) **THAT**, the Society has created employment to hundreds of youths in Embakasi West Constituency and more than fifty thousand Kenyan citizens directly and indirectly through slot and gaming machines. The said machines are owned, run and managed by Kenyans as well as directly benefiting Kenyan Communities;
- iv) **THAT**, the Members of the society in the last few months have been arbitrarily arrested, harassed and their constitutional rights violated, slot and gaming machines confiscated, destroyed and burnt hence their earning stolen in the process;



- v) **THAT**, in the recent past, there has been a crackdown on slot/gaming machines and thousands of youth and members of the society rendered jobless, hence affecting the economy negatively;
- vi) **THAT**, efforts to resolve this matter with relevant government agencies have been futile; and
- vii) **THAT**, the matter presented in this petition is not pending before any tribunal, court of law or independent body;
- viii) **THAT**, the National Assembly, through the Departmental Committee on Sports, Culture and Tourism:-
  - a) Cause an investigation into the alleged harassment of the Members of the Counties Amusement and Gaming Society and confiscation of their property by authorities;
  - b) Recommends that Kenyans be allowed to own, manage and franchise slot and gaming machines as stipulated by the Betting, lotteries and Gaming Act; and
  - c) Makes any other order or direction that it deems fit in the circumstances of the matter.

### 3.0 SUBMISSIONS AND EVIDENCE

#### 3.1 Petitioner- Hon. George Theuri, MP

Having been seized of the Petition, the Committee invited the Hon. George Theuri, MP, for a briefing session on 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2018, he was accompanied by other petitioners whom he presented the petition to the National Assembly on their behalf. During the meeting, the Hon. George Theuri, MP informed the Committee as follows:

1. He was presenting the petition on behalf of the Counties Amusement and Gaming Society who had approached him to do so.
2. Thirty three (33) Members of the Society had signed the petition.
3. The society was formed with the express intention of allowing ordinary Kenyans from all walk of lives to be part of the gaming and amusement industry and build their livelihoods from it. By Self-Regulation and adherence to the rule of law in regard to betting and gaming, the intention has and always will be to provide employment opportunities and generate income for the members of the society;
4. The society is a professional and dedicated society that is in no way associated with the entities that have been operating gaming slot machines illegally and or immorally;
5. The society have paid for licenses to the following county governments: Nairobi, Kericho, Narok, Kajiado, Homabay and Nakuru. On numerous occasions, the society have tried to communicate to the Betting Control and Licensing Board but have received no reply or communication in regards to any additional license requirements;
6. The society has a strict code of conduct and internal regulations to ensure promotion of responsible gambling where underage, people with mental challenges and those struggling with addiction are not allowed to bet;
7. The society has written to the Cabinet Secretary for Interior and Coordination of National Government and have tried visiting Betting Control and Licensing Board for consultative meetings and seeking for any additional licensing requirements but no response has been forthcoming.

8. The Society has created employment to hundreds of youths in Embakasi West Constituency and more than fifty thousand Kenyan citizens directly and indirectly through slot and gaming machines. The said machines are owned, run and managed by Kenyans as well as directly benefiting Kenyan Communities;
9. In the recent past, there has been a crackdown on slot/gaming machines and thousands of youth and members of the society rendered jobless, hence affecting the economy negatively;

#### 4.0 COMMITTEE'S OBSERVATIONS

Upon analyzing the petition and through interaction with the Petitioners, the Committee made the following observations:

1. The Counties Amusement and Gaming Society (herein referred to as the Society) is registered society of persons who are engaged in the gaming and amusement industry with over 600 members;
2. Some Members of the Society had been charged in court for various offences which were withdrawn by the Office of the Directorate of Public Prosecution under section 87(a) of the Criminal procedure Code;
3. Members of the Society have filed various Petitions in several courts challenging the harassment by the Police; a case in point is the Constitutional Petition Number 482 of 2018 which has all the registered members of the Society as Petitioners in the matter.
4. The HC. Pet. No. 482 of 2018 was filed in July 2018 against the Betting Control and Licensing Board, the Ministry of Interior and Co-ordination of National Government, Inspector General, Attorney General, Office of the Directorate of Public Prosecution, Council of Governors and Inter-Governmental Technical Relations Committee.
5. The HC. Pet. No. 482 of 2018 was mentioned on the 25<sup>th</sup> July 2018 whereas the Petition before the Committee was tabled in the House on the 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 during the subsistence of the suit in Court.
6. The Petition did not disclose whether there were pending matter in court contrary to the Petitions to Parliament (Procedure) Act, the Petitioners therefore did not disclose all the information as required raising the question of *sub judice*. The petitioners therefore failed the test of equity of full disclosure.

**5.0 COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION**

Having considered the Petition and the prayers sought, the Committee recommends that **the Petition be dismissed pursuant to Standing Order 89.**

1. The society indicated that they have 600 registered members but no proof has been provided or list of the registered members to support this;
2. No documentation has been provided in support of adherence to the set standards as indicated by the petitioners/society;
3. The members of the society indicated that there has been harassment by the government but failed to furnish the Committee with the specific cases in support of the allegations;
4. Concerned whether there is any court case filed, proceedings or court process by any member of the society, the Committee observed from the petitioners that there are a few cases in court by part of the members of the society in different areas. Pursuant to S.O. 89, matters Sub Judice or Secret, the Committee resolved to suspend the matter until the petitioners provide relevant court documents on the cases filed in court and their status.

The petitioners were then directed to table the documents and all evidence from the court on the matters before the Committee during its next sitting to be held on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2018.

That on or about the 28<sup>th</sup> Day of January, 2018, at Kimunyo market in within Gatundu, you approached the business premises of the aforesaid and issued death threats to one JANE NJERI KARIUKI. The facts surrounding the said matter are within the purview of your knowledge.

What is appalling is that in the course of the said incidence, you uttered words to the complainant to wit: "I want to know the godfather of this place, and if takes to put someone down I will do it." Words which were construed to maim, injure and/or kill the complainant herein in the course of her business or whoever you purport to be the godfather'. The complainant later on called and informed her dad and her employer regarding the same acts. A complaint was also raised at Gatundu Police station too.

To date, the complainant has been living in fear on her life as to that threat. This is a serious complaint raised against a public officer of your rank and the reputation of the Office you hold. This act also goes against the tenets of principles of justice, the law regulating police officers and the Constitution of Kenya, 2010.

We are instructed to bring this complaint to your attention and various government institutions copied in this letter that are responsible to investigate the complaint. The

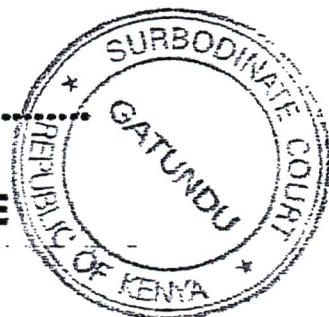

**HARASSMENT OF SOCIETY MEMBERS, CONFISCATION AND DESTRUCTION OF SLOT AND GAMING MACHINES.**

The COUNTIES AMUSEMENT AND GAMING SOCIETY has been in existence since 2016 and registered under the societies act registration number 49897 of year 2017. The COUNTIES AMUSEMENT AND GAMING SOCIETY is 100% owned and run by Kenyans.

Kindly allow me to bring the attention of this honorable committee of the following grievances from the COUNTIES AMUSEMENT AND GAMING SOCIETY.

We formed the COUNTIES AMUSEMENT AND GAMING SOCIETY with the express intention of allowing ordinary Kenyans from all walk of lives to be part of the gaming and amusement industry and build their livelihoods from it. By Self Regulation and adherence to the rule of LAW in regards to betting and gaming, our intention has and always will be to provide employment opportunities and generate income for our members.

We are a professional and dedicated society that is in no way associated with the entities that have been operating gaming slot machines illegally and or immorally.

We decry the continuous harassment, confiscation and burning of our machines by Regional Co-ordinators, County Commissioners, D.Os, Chiefs and Police Officers under the instructions of Cabinet Secretary Interior Dr. Fred Matiangi. We consider this harassment illegal and unconstitutional.

While arbitrarily harassing genuine members of the COUNTIES AMUSEMENT AND GAMING SOCIETY other companies running almost similar businesses but co-owned by foreigners continue to thrive across the country. These companies are running similar set ups as us and are allowed to operate without a license and with temporary arrangements. Find attached pictures to illustrate our point, it is worth noting that this business is constitutional and there is no legal valid explanation at all why we have been victimized. Our society consists mainly of Kenyan youths who have come together in groups in each county and who basically try to earn a living legally through slot machines to be able to buy food, pay school fees and medical bills for their young families. Our society has an office in Ngara Nairobi as the head office while county branches have offices in their respective counties. We have managed to set up systems and operations procedures to comply with all laws of the land in regards to Betting and Control.

We have as a Society paid for licenses to the following county governments: Nairobi, Kericho, Narok, Kajiado, , Homabay, and Nakuru. We have attached all of them herein for ease of your perusal. On numerous occasions we have tried communicating to the Betting Control and Licensing Board but we have received no reply or communication in regards to any additional license requirements. Under our

own initiative we have tried to sit down with betting regulators but to no avail. Please find copies and correspondence of applications to that effect.

The Betting Control and Licensing Board is mandated by law as a core function to

- I. Licensing and controlling betting premises and activities carried therein.
- II. Authorizing and controlling prize competitions and lotteries.
- III. Curbing illegal gambling.
- IV. Formulating and implementing gaming Policies.
- V. Facilitating the development and enforcement of gaming laws in Kenya.
- VI. Encourage a conducive environment in which the gaming industry adds value to overall national development.
- VII. Advocating for betting, lotteries and gaming as legitimate consumer pursuits.

It is therefore puzzling for a gaming society like ours to be persecuted while those super brands of gambling whose revenues collected, we know are not retained in the Kenyan economy enjoy a monopoly and attract the unilateral interest of the Betting Control and Licensing Board.

Our society has a strict code of conduct and internal regulations to ensure promotion of responsible gambling where under age, people with mental challenges and those struggling with addiction are not allowed to bet. This is done by ensuring our slot machines are kept inside enclosed premises with proper visibility arrangements on the entrance ensuring those outside cannot see what is going on inside and a full time guard confirming only responsible adults are allowed in. Some of our members will also put machines in entertainment spots where none of the above is allowed.

Our slot/gaming machines have created employment to thousands of youth in this country where each member has an average of 50 machines and every 3 machine requires 2 attendants and one technician that translate to about 90,000 direct employment and thousands other indirectly only by our society. Comparing the above figures with our competitors doing online gaming with very few employees logic will tell you which one is better owing to the fact that Kenya is a labor surplus market with thousands of our youth looking for employment.

We have written to the Cabinet Secretary Interior asking for consultative meetings to regularize the slot/gaming industry, seeking to understand what is undesirable with our business even though it is legal, so that we can formulate new policies where necessary. We have also on numerous occasions tried visiting Betting Control and Licensing Board offices asking for any additional licensing requirements but no response has been forthcoming. It was therefore very sad to hear our premises broken into by county administrative officers and police both regular and APs. The subsequent destruction of our property either through confiscation, or burning was by all means illegal and draconian. This has led to massive losses through lost machines and stolen cash belonging to ordinary Kenyans in addition to thousands of jobs being lost.

Honorable committee of Parliament we come before you as equal opportunity employers, with a vast presence in this country grounded to the common Mwananchi. We have watched as bigger players, with deeper pockets gain monopoly of the gaming industry with revenue going out of the country as opposed to remaining in this country. Our revenue remains in the country, our workers are paid within the

country, we comply with all licenses on County Level and still we are told that we cannot operate and do business. We have the capacity to institute reforms within our society, we have the capacity to engage both the National and County Governments on this issue but every time we try we are met with closed doors and cold stares.

The COUNTIES AMUSEMENT AND GAMING SOCIETY is ready to restructure its operations to conform to any requirements required by the government.

Our request to this honorable committee is to protect Kenyan entrepreneurship by allowing our society to continue transacting business throughout the country and ordering the immediate surrender of assets belonging to members of the COUNTIES AMUSEMENT AND GAMING SOCIETY illegally detained.

We also request that COUNTIES AMUSEMENT AND GAMING SOCIETY be regularized, licensed by licensing authorities, in both national and county governments and recognized as a legal association as well as an equal opportunity empowerer.

Being cognizant of this fact, as COUNTIES AMUSEMENT AND GAMING SOCIETY we support the removal of foreigners who use corrupt means to run illegal Slot/Gaming machines and tarnish the hard work of thousands of Kenyans. As a society we support all genuine measures to regularize and protect the rights and property of hardworking Kenyans.

Condemning Slot/Gaming Machines as evil without working into the finer details of fair business practices, compliance and policy formulation involving taxation smacks of ill will and the influence of powerful unseen hands hell bent on destroying us. We pray that this honorable committee will see fit to consider our proposals for regulation of this industry.

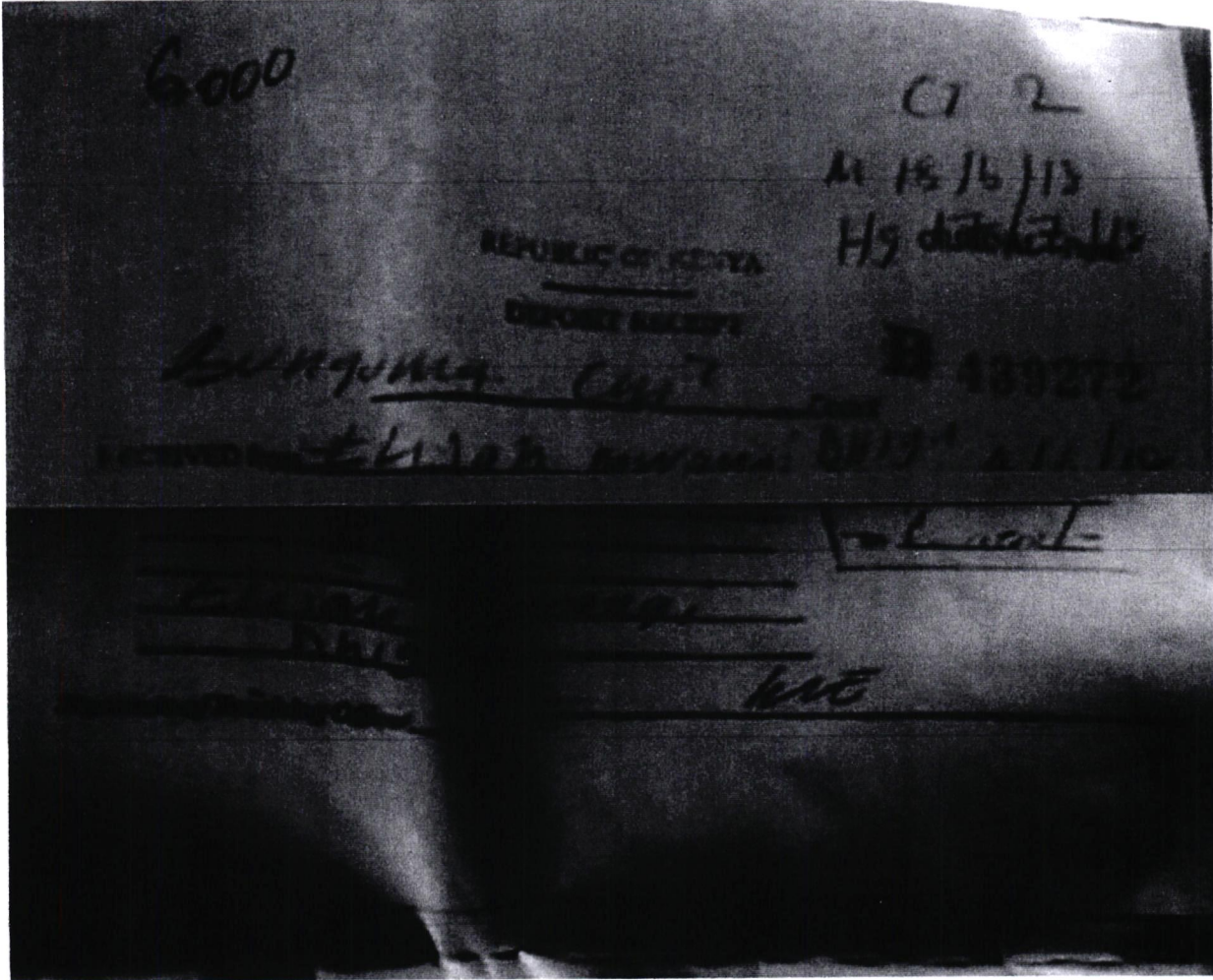
